1 IDENTIFICATION

This FCO gives information about release v0035 of the IP DECT Unified Support Tool (UST), which is the successor of release v0028.

The UST is designed as a tool for upgrading FW on IP DECT Handsets. UST is an alternative to using the legacy "FL7_FlashLoaderGUI" with the UART cable and can be used to perform up to 8 handset FW upgrades in parallel, over standard USB Hub connections via Handset USB interface.

The M166 is supported in UST, using the UART Cable (Gx66 Download Cable)

Please consult the UST **Menu/Help** for user guide information and upgrade instructions.

UART based upgrades require *.hex files.

USB based upgrades require *.bin files.

This release is supported on the following Operating Systems:

- Windows 7 Professional/Enterprise/Ultimate (32 and 64 bit)
- Windows 8.1 Professional/Enterprise (32 and 64 bit)
- Windows 10 Professional (32 and 64 bit)

Other recent Windows O/S may be compatible but are not tested.

Installation is performed automatically by the executable file provided. Following the on screen instructions.

5 FUNCTIONAL CHANGES

The Following functional changes are introduced:

- Support for new generation Gx77 handsets
- Firmware compatibility check

G266 and G277 upgrade uses UART Cable interface.
